For all calls: 406-745-2768 A BEAUTIFUL LOVE SONG TO GOD. A few weeks ago, a parish in Missoula, Mont., participated in a Lenten retreat. The theme for their reflection was taken from the first chapter of John: "What are you looking for?" (1:38). One person remarked that the experience of praying with the Gospel of John for nine days was like listening to a beautiful love song to our Lord. This is a helpful description to begin to see what the fourth Evangelist is trying to communicate to his audience and to the world. If the Gospel of John is crafted like a beautiful love song, then today's Gospel passage from John 12 can be understood as a crescendo moment in that music.

As the church nears the end of this somber season. the Gospel of John ascends to a beautiful interpretation of Jesus' approaching hour of glorification. Jesus' purpose is to show a life given away freely, happily. This is not the sorrow of the synoptic tradition's rendition of the passion. In the fourth Gospel, Jesus' hour is a happy one. The followers of Jesus are asked to embrace this same hourif possible, with somber joy. - Fr. Victor Cancino, SJ
