As the Easter season progresses, the Sunday readings provide images of and reflections on divine intimacy. This promise is especially clear in this Sunday's second reading. John, in one of his letters, summarizes discipleship in one succinct idea: to believe in the name Jesus Christ, and to love one another just as he commanded us (1 Jn 3:23). Those who do so will be drawn into the same divine relationship that Jesus experienced every moment of his life. John assures his audience that "those who keep his commandments remain in him and he in them" (1 Jn 3:24). Believing in Christ and loving our neighbor will open us to the same refulgent life that brought Jesus back from the dead.

This Sunday's readings remind us that the cradle of Christianity is modern-day Israel, Palestine, and Syria. In this Sunday's first reading, Luke reminds us that the church was at peace in that place. Today we also know how much conflict exists in that same place. The readings invite the faithful to pause this week and bring peace into the world through prayer and through intimacy with the Lord. This is the path of peace that Jesus offered to his disciples, and remains a path that anyone who prays can follow. Those who share divine life with God will bear much fruit, because without God, we can do nothing (Jn 15:5). – Fr. Victor Cancino, SJ
